Frequently Asked Questions

What about the Medicare Prescription Drug Benefit?

We do not participate in any Medicare-sponsored insurance plans. However, since our drug prices are on average 60-80% less expensive than they are in the US, most people do save a lot of money by opting-out of the Medicare Prescription Drug Benefit and buying their medications through us.

What About the Medicare "Doughnut Hole"?

If you're in the "doughnut hole", consider buying from us to save up to 80%. Even if you expect to reach the other side of the doughnut hole before the end of the year, your total out-of-pocket cost will still be significantly less buying from us. Consider this, the doughnut hole is the gap in coverage between \$2,700 and \$4,350. That's \$1,650 out of your pocket. With us you would only spend around \$415.

Why are our medications so inexpensive?

In the United States drug companies are issued patents that cause a monopoly, allowing them to charge any price they see fit. In India, the government allows manufacturers to produce generic copies of brand name medications. This brings natural competition pushing prices down.

Tell me more about India's Pharmaceutical Industry?

- India is the largest producer of generic medications in the world. India's Pharmaceutical Industry is the 4th largest in the world.
- Many of the generic drugs on the shelves at your local US pharmacy come from drug companies in India – the same drug companies Global Pharmacy Canada buys from.
- India is the world's largest democracy with over one billion people.
- America's largest corporations have outsourced operations to India, taking advantage of their highly skilled, professional workforce.
- Every year, thousands of American citizens travel to India to receive world-class medical care (Time Magazine, May 29, 2006).
- Many of the brand-name drugs in the United States are manufactured with base ingredients supplied by India.

Why can we only fill a prescription for a maximum of three months?

The FDA considers quantities greater than a 3-month supply to be "not for personal use" and will block the shipment at the border.

Can we order Valium or Tylenol 3?

No. The FDA does not allow people to import any narcotic, habit-forming or controlled substances.

What about refills?

Our free refill reminder service will contact you by mail before you run out of your medications.

How soon will I receive my shipment?

All orders will be delivered in approximately 2 weeks from receipt of your prescriptions.

What's the fastest way to get my medication?

The fastest way is to use our website (www.globalpharmacycanada.com) to place your order, pay by credit card and fax in your prescriptions toll-free to 1-866-655-8460.

How can I pay for my order?

You can pay by Visa or Check. (Make Check payable to Global Pharmacy Canada) We do not accept Mastercard or American Express.

How much is shipping?

One flat rate of \$12 will cover shipping for all the medications in your order.

My prescriptions are on file at my regular pharmacy. What should I do?

You can either make an appointment with your doctor to get new prescriptions, send us a copy/photo of your pill bottle's label, or send us your detailed pharmacy receipt/invoice.

Is a prescription required?

Yes. All medications ordered from us must have been prescribed by a medical practitioner. To provide us with your prescriptions, either send or fax us a copy of the original prescription, or you can send a copy/picture of the pill bottle's label, or send us your detailed pharmacy receipt/invoice.

What about the quality and safety of the medications?

All the drugs we supply are government approved. The manufacturers we buy from follow strict World Health Organization standards for Good Manufacturing Processes (GMP).

Generic medications are just as safe and effective as their brand-name equivalents. Due to strict government regulations, generic medications are, by law, the exact same medicine as the original brand name drug, simply made by another company.
